**Survey: Most voters don't know who leaked BHC files**

Voters appear to be somewhat switched off from the saga surrounding the leaked Bermuda Housing Corporation files.

Earlier this month businessman Harold Darrell admitted leaking the confidential police files to the Mid Ocean News but when pollsters Research.bm asked voters who they thought had leaked them, 47 per cent said they had no idea.

The poll, conducted after Mr. Darrell's admission, put the question to 402 voters; 31 per cent believed a former PLP supporter or member had leaked them and 12 per cent said the UBP. Only seven per cent attributed the leak to Larry Dennis, the Auditor General. Research.bm also asked voters to rate how confident they were about whether there would be more affordable housing in ten years.

The company says just over a third (34 per cent) were confident, although further breakdowns show blacks were more confident (48 per cent) as were people over the age of 65 (50 per cent).
